Description

A smooth nine-sided three dimensional ceramic geometric form (nonahedron) sits at a slant on an eleven –sided (hendecagon)

geometric form. The nonahedron is red, yellow, orange and deep blue. The hendecagon is deep blue, light blue, orange and green. Ken Price produced only a few of these shapes in the 80's. It is housed in a glass sided rectangular wood box designed by and manufactured for Ken Price.
